

CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
CITY OF MAYFIELD, KENTUCKY
January 11, 2010

The City Council of the City of Mayfield, Kentucky, met in regular session on Monday January 11, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall, Mayfield, Kentucky. There were present Mayor Arthur Byrn, Council members Jon Redd, Phil Myers, Barry McDonald, Mark Waggoner, Sharon Green, Charles Whitnell, Kathy O'Nan, Nick Summers and Al Page; Fire Chief Mike Jones, City Planner Brad Rodgers, Chief of Police Barry Rice, City Attorney Boyd Neely, and City Clerk Tamie Johnson.

Council member Barry McDonald led the Council in prayer.

Mayor Byrn read the conditions for attendance for a City of Mayfield Council Meeting.

Mr. Denver Hobbs, 215 N 8th Street, addressed the Council concerning the no parking zone in front of his business, Hobbs Appliance, located on West Broadway.

Mr. Johnny Jackson arrived at 6:05 p.m.

Mr. Gary Hobbs, 246 Big Valley Drive, Mayfield, also addressed the Council concerning the no parking zone in front of his father's business.

On a motion by Waggoner, and seconded by O'Nan, and with Redd, Myers, McDonald, Jackson, Waggoner, Green, Whitnell, O'Nan, Summers, and Page voting yea, and with none voting nay, Council approved the minutes from the December 14, 2009, meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. William T. Brown addressed the Council concerning the renewal of the City's health insurance.

NEW BUSINESS

On a motion by Myers, and seconded by Page, and with Redd, Myers, McDonald, Jackson, Waggoner, Green, Whitnell, O'Nan, Summers and Page voting yea, and with none voting nay, Council approved on first reading **Fiscal Ordinance 1-10**, "An ordinance adopting the annual budget for the City of Mayfield, Kentucky, for the fiscal year July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010, estimating revenues and resources and appropriating funds for the operation of city government." Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Myers, and seconded by Redd, to approve **Ordinance 1-10** (Option 2) "An ordinance addressing parking on West Broadway" with the change from 15 minutes to 30 minutes.

On a motion by Jackson, and seconded by McDonald, and with Page, Summers, Jackson and McDonald voting yea, and with O'Nan, Whitnell, Green, Waggoner, Myers, and Redd voting nay, Council failed to amend **Ordinance 1-10** (Option 2) to leave the 15 minute unloading zone as stated in the ordinance instead of the 30 minutes as motioned. Motion failed four to six.

So then on the motion made by Myers, and seconded by Redd, and with Redd, Myers, Waggoner, Green, Whitnell, O'Nan voting yea, and with McDonald, Jackson, Summers and Page voting nay, Council approved on first reading **Ordinance 1-10** (Option 2) "An ordinance addressing parking on West Broadway". Motion passed six to four.

A motion was made by Jackson, and seconded by Page, and with Page, Summers, O'Nan, Whitnell, Green, Waggoner, Jackson, McDonald, Myers and Redd voting yea, and with none voting nay, Council approved **Municipal Order 1-10** appointing Pat Vincent to fill the unexpired four-year term of Jim Kirkwood, on the Housing Authority Board. This term shall expire on December 31, 2012. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Green, and seconded by O'Nan, and with Myers, McDonald, Jackson, Waggoner, Green, Whitnell, O'Nan, Summers, and Page voting yea, and with none voting nay, Council approved **Municipal Order 2-10** re-appointing Doug Redd to the Mayfield Housing Authority for a four-year term to expire December 31, 2013. Mr. Jon Redd abstained from voting because he is Doug Redd's bother. Motion passed nine to zero with one abstention.

A motion was made by Summers, and seconded by Waggoner, and with Page, Summers, O’Nan, Whitnell, Green, Waggoner, Jackson, McDonald, Myers and Redd voting yea, and with none voting nay, Council approved **Municipal Orders 3, 6, 7 & 8 - 10**. Motion passed unanimously. The municipal orders are as follows:

Municipal Order 3-10 re-appointing Pat Doughty to the Mayfield Tourism Commission for a three-year term to expire December 31, 2012.

Municipal Order 6-10 appointing Regina Williams to the Mayfield Tourism Commission for a three-year term to replace Jeff Lamb, who has resigned. This term shall expire December 31, 2012.

Municipal Order 7-10 appointing Leslie Goodman to the Mayfield Tourism Commission for a three-year term to replace Karen Leigh, who has resigned. This term shall expire December 31, 2012.

Municipal Order 8-10 appointing Cynthia Elder to the Mayfield Tourism Commission for a three-year term to replace Tamra Fakhoorian. This term shall expire December 31, 2012.

A motion was made by Page, and seconded by Whitnell, and with Redd, Myers, McDonald, Jackson, Waggoner, Green, Whitnell, O’Nan, Summers and Page voting yea, and with none voting nay, Council approved **Municipal Order 4-10** re-appointing Carol Todd to the Mayfield Human Rights Commission for a four-year term to expire on January 31, 2014. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by McDonald, and seconded by Myers, and with Page, Summers, O’Nan, Whitnell, Green, Waggoner, Jackson, McDonald, Myers and Redd voting yea, and with none voting nay, Council approved **Municipal Order 5-10** re-appointing Daniel Hale to the Mayfield Planning Commission for a four-year term to expire on December 31, 2013. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Myers, and seconded by Redd, and with Redd, Myers, McDonald, Jackson, Waggoner, Green, Whitnell, O’Nan, Summers and Page voting yea, and with none voting nay, Council approved **Resolution 1-1-10** "A resolution declaring items as surplus." Motion passed unanimously.

With no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 7:43 p.m.
